

Often dubbed the "Little Versailles", **Rundale Palace Complex** (18th century) is certainly one of the most famous and beautiful historical sites in Latvia. With Baroque and Rococo-style architecture, extensive gardens and sculptures, it's a worthwhile site to visit.


Day 4: VILNIUS – KAUNAS

Kaunas, the second largest Lithuania's city, which keeps the authentic spirit of the country's national character alive surrounded by it's two rivers. Don't miss notable places such as Kaunas Town Hall, the Kaunas Castle, House of Perkūnas, and many churches.

Pazaislis Monastery is one of the most impressive architectural examples of late Italian baroque in North East Europe.

On a peninsula washed by the Curonian Lagoon and under one of the main bird migration routes is the **Ventės Ragas** Ornithological Station. Each year, tens of thousands of birds are ringed at the station. Next to the impressive traps, there is also the oldest lighthouse in Lithuania. Its doors are open to visitors who want to get a bird's-eye view of the wavy waters and the golden dunes of the Curonian Spit emerging in the distance.

Designated a national park (UNESCO) in 1991, Curonian Spit trails across the Baltic Sea from Lithuania to Russian territory Kaliningrad. 70% of the area is rural, and you will have a chance to visit urban **Nida** town and Thomas Mann Summer House. Until the first decades of the 20th century, most of the spit was German territory.

Day 7: KLAIPEDA – RUMSISKES – VILNIUS

In a picturesque landscape, surrounded by meadows and forests, windmills, old wooden churches, the farms and beehives are inviting to come and visit. Homes are authentically equipped and furnished. All of this can be seen in museum-village in **Rumsiskes**.

After entertaining Lahemaa tour, there is a degustation of 5 different sorts of vodka and you hear stories about traditions how to drink vodka. Taste also freshly baked black rye bread, pickles and salted pork – all the snacks that suit perfectly to vodka.

Day 4: TARTU – GAUJA NATIONAL PARK – RIGA



As well as the ramparts and towers, were built by Swedish and Russian and many more. **Gauja National Park** visit with entrance to Turaida castle - following the classic Livonian red-brick style of construction.

Today awaits a visit to **Rūndale Palace**. It is to Latvia what Versailles is to France or L'Hermitage is to Russia. Later heading for beer tasting at **Pakruojis Manor House**. Pakruojis manor "Žaldokas" is perhaps the only one who is brewing beer at the authentic wooden vats and barrels in Lithuania. Here guests can learn and get acquainted with regulations of the Baron and history of the highly appreciated beer and brewery.


Day 3: VILNIUS – TRAKAI - VENTE

Another interesting fact is the Karaites living there. A typical Karaite dish is kibinai. These dumplings were traditionally filled with lamb, today there is pretty much every filling. Try yourself at a cooking lesson and then taste your homemade kibinai! Drive along the river Memel (Raudone and Panemune castles) to Vente. Here you can visit the oldest bird observatory in Europe.



Day 4: VENTE – NIDA

In the morning Boat trip to **Curonian Spit**. During the trip you will admire the Curonian Spit and its rich wild animal and bird life on the Nemunas Delta. Designated a national park (UNESCO) in 1991, Curonian Spit trails across the Baltic Sea from Lithuania to Russian territory Kaliningrad. 70% of the area is rural, and you will have a chance to visit urban Nida town and Thomas Mann Summer House. Until the first decades of the 20th century, most of the spit was German territory.

This park is a large nature preserve, best known for his giant marsh (bog) landscapes. In some places the swamp is as deep as of twelve storey building! Beautiful wooden pathways are laid out so you can visit the park safe and enjoy the immense beauty of the Latvian nature.

The image - known as the "Divine Mercy" - is purported to have miraculous healing properties, leading to Faustyna's eventual canonisation by Pope John Paul II in 2000. A big proponent of the cult of Faustyna, during WWII the future pope prayed at this site every day.

Wieliczka Salt Mine – one of the largest underground mining museums in the world, where white gold, called salt, was extracted from the ground. It's a subterranean labyrinth of tunnels and chambers – about 300km distributed over nine levels, the deepest being 327m underground. It is also a world class monument, featuring on the UNESCO's World Cultural and Natural Heritage List.

Day 3: KRAKOW – KALWARIA ZEBRZYDOWSKA – WADOWICE - CZESTOCHOWA

Just 35 km from Kraków, in the town of **Kalwaria Zebrzydowska**, surrounded by hills and green valleys, stands the Bernardine Monastery. This monastery is one of the most important pilgrimage centers in Poland. Still a little boy, Karol Józef Wojtyła came here with her father. The Sanctuary of Calvary was the place of prayer of the future John Paul II.

After visiting of Bernardines sanctuary in Kalwaria, further drive to the hometown of John Paul II – Wadowice. Visit John Paul II Family Home Museum and Minor Basilica of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary where John Paul II was baptized.



Day 4: CZESTOCHOWA – NIEPOKALANOW - WARSAW

Visit the Sanctuary of Black Madonna Shrine in Jasna Gora Monastery. The Pauline monastery at Jasna Góra in Częstochowa is the foremost centre of religious life in Poland, and one of the best known Marian sanctuaries in Europe and the world.

Drive to **Niepokalanow** to visit the Sanctuary of Immaculate Virgin Mary, the Franciscan monastery founded by St. Maximilian Kolbe.

Niepokalanów is the name of the Franciscan monastery located in the village of Paprotnia. The monastery was founded in 1927 by Father Maksymilian Kolbe, who came here with a group of 20 brothers from Grodno. In 1954, the Basilica was consecrated, whose construction was begun by Father Maksymilian before the war. In 1983, Holy Father John Paul II came to Niepokalanów with a pilgrimage.

Day 5: WARSAW

Warsaw is a must visit due to the fact that it's Old Town entered on the UNESCO World Heritage List. As well as the Royal Route is very famous for foreign visitors. In the early 17th century, Andrejus Valavičius, the standard-bearer of the Lithuanian Grand Duchy, began construction of the **Tytuvėnai Monastery** complex. It was built initially in the Gothic spirit, and then intertwined with Renaissance-style details. However, the largest proportion of the monastery is dedicated to Baroque architecture. Today, this Franciscan monastery is in excellent condition, and is a unique architectural monument located deep in the heart of rural Lithuania.

Church of Our Lady of the Angels and Bernardine monastery complex in Tytuvėnai are among Lithuania's largest and most significant specimens of 17th and 18th century sacred architecture, reflecting as they do a multi-layered harmony of the gothic, mannerist and baroque styles. The ensemble consists of a church, a courtyard with the Holy Steps Chapel, and the stone wall of a two-story monastery.



Day 1: VILNIUS

Arrival in Vilnius. Transfer to the hotel and check-in.

Day 2: VILNIUS – TRAKAI – VILNIUS

City Tour in Vilnius. **Vilnius** - a unique baroque city. The green of the gardens, the red of the roof tiles and the yellow of the house walls - Vilnius reflects three colours of the Lithuanian flag.

In Vilnius Cathedral square, after announcement on radio at 19:00 people started to stand in a line, linked their hands and this way created a living chain of people. It began at the foot of Gediminas tower and ended near Toompea castle in Tallinn. In Vilnius you can find a few signs commemorating this event, such as: The Freedom Road of Vilnius sculpture and a footmark on a brick symbolizing participant of the Baltic Way.

Short trip to Trakai. Trakai being a centre of the National park is also a popular and casual destination of visitors from Vilnius. Trakai castle is the only Gothic water castle in Europe that survived from the 14th century.

Day 3: VILNIUS – PANEVĖŽYS – HILL OF CROSSES – BAUSKA - RIGA

The Baltic Way continued through a smaller town (compared to Vilnius) – **Panevėžys**.

In 2014 commemorative signs/information stands were unveiled at five rest stops along the Vilnius–Panevėžys highway to mark the 25th anniversary of the Baltic Way: at kilometres 32.1 and 80.1 on the left side, and kilometres 38.5, 55.6 and 99.9 on the right side.

The next stop is at the **Hill of Crosses**. The Catholic faith expressed in the unique Hill of Crosses in Siauliai, Lithuania will surprise every visitor. The hill is covered with thousands of crosses of different materials. Each cross holds a strong and desperate prayer of the Lithuanian people. In Soviet times, there were several attempts to remove the crosses, but again, the new crosses were set up.


Day 4: RIGA

City Tour in Riga. **Riga** - Elegance of Art Nouveau. Riga was once one of the most important trading centres in the Baltic region. Today, it is the economic, political and cultural centre of the country. The city was founded in 1201, when the Bishop Albert with monks arrived to the city and built a castle.

Riga was a middle point of this liberation movement. A small red granite 'footprint' at the crossroads of Kalķu and Valņū (near McDonald's) serves as a reminder of that amazing event.

Day 5: RIGA – CĒSIS – PARNU - TALLINN

On this day trip to Tallinn awaits. On the way – short stop in **Parnu**. It is unclear when and by whom the idea of a human chain was advanced but it appears that the idea was proposed during a trilateral meeting in Parnu on 15 July 1989. However, the final joint decisions were taken a month later, on August 12, near **Cēsis**.



Day 6: TALLINN

Tallinn – The nest of medieval Gothic. The authenticity of the old town makes Tallinn unique. Today the Tallinn's old town is surrounded by the thick stonewalls and towers of the medieval fortification.

The demonstrators of Baltic Way peacefully linked hands for 15 minutes at 19:00 local time. The first two Baltic Way memorials were erected in Estonia already on the day of the Baltic Way.



The self-proclaimed "Republic" of **Užupis** is Vilnius' Bohemian and artistic district. It has its own anthem, constitution, president, bishop, two churches, the Bernadine Cemetery – one of the oldest in the city -, seven bridges, and its own guardian called The Bronze Angel of Užupis, who was put in the centre of the district in 2002. In Lithuanian, Užupis means 'behind the river' and this is proclaimed in a number of languages on its entrance sign. The Vilnelė is the district's river, and is home to Lithuania's only mermaid – she's not real, don't worry! But she lives on the embankment, and those who give in to her charms will remain in Užupis forever.

Day 3: VILNIUS – TRAKAI – RUMSISKES – KAUNAS

Trakai is the city situated between 3 lakes, and represents Lithuania for more than two million tourists every year. It is well known for its natural beauty of landscapes, wildlife reserves, forests and the island castle on lake Galvė which is the only one of its kind in Europe.

Rumsiskes, one of the largest open-air ethnographic museums in Europe, exhibits the buildings of all Lithuanian regions and reconstructs the domestic life, work and traditions of Lithuanian peasants and city dwellers. It resembles a miniature version of Lithuania of the 18th–20th centuries where you can see hundred years old homesteads, mills, various workshops, agricultural implements and feel the spirit of the past in authentic interiors.



Day 4: KAUNAS – PAŽAISLIS MONASTERY – KLAIPEDA

Kaunas, the second largest Lithuania's city, which keeps the authentic spirit of the country's national character alive surrounded by it's two rivers. Don't miss notable places such as Kaunas Town Hall, the Kaunas Castle, House of Perkūnas, and many churches.

Pažaislis Monastery is quite possibly the most romantic place in Lithuania. A genuine baroque diamond from the 17th century. The sound of music beneath the arches of the church reveals its beauty as many concerts and music festivals take place here. The silence of the monastery is managed by the order of the Sisters of St. Casimir. In the southern part of the monastery you will find the Sacral Heritage Museum of the Pažaislis Monastery.

Day 5: KLAIPEDA. CURONIAN SPIT & BOAT TRIP

The main seaport of Lithuania **Klaipeda** is situated at the mouth of the Curonian lagoon in the Baltic Sea and is known as the "Lithuanian gateway to the world." With it's unique German-influenced old town Klaipeda has to offer other sightseeing's such as the Theatre Square, the sculpture of Ann from Tharau, sailing vessel Meridianas etc.

Designated a national park (UNESCO) in 1991, **Curonian Spit** trails across the Baltic Sea from Lithuania to Russian territory Kaliningrad. 70% of the area is rural, and you will have a chance to visit urban Nida town and Thomas Mann Summer House. Until the first decades of the 20th century, most of the spit was German territory.

Day 6: KLAIPEDA – HILL OF CROSSES – RUNDALE PALACE – RIGA

Lithuania's legendary Hill of Crosses is a symbol of defiance and part of a pilgrimage site. More than 200,000 crosses have been planted on this low hill. The tradition began during the 1831 Uprising and reached its height in the 1960s, in defiance of anti-religious Soviet rule. This place was granted a visit of John Paul II in 1993.

Often dubbed the "Little Versailles", **Rundale Palace Complex** (18th century) is certainly one of the most famous and beautiful historical sites in Latvia. With Baroque and Rococo-style architecture, extensive gardens and sculptures, it's a worthwhile site to visit.

Day 7: RIGA

During city tour in **Riga** you will see the Cathedral, St. Peter's Church, the Powder Tower, the Small and the Great Guild, the House of Blackheads, the "Three Brothers" and many more. Lahemaa is one of Europe's most important forest conservation areas. During a tour through the narrow small paths of the park you come across a beautifully restored old farmhouses. The magnificent Palmse manor is like a pearl of the National Park.

Day 9: LAHEMAA NATIONAL PARK – FISHING VILLAGES ON THE ESTONIAN COAST – TALLINN

Just like 4000 years ago, you can find historical villages on the limestone cliff that runs through Lahemaa. From here fishermen went to the islands of Finland to catch fish and seals; the sea was used for friendly trade as well as for the smuggling of salt and spirits. The most famous fishing villages here are the captains' village of Käsmu, the fishermen's village of Altja and the village of spirit smugglers, Viinistu – now the location of an art museum.

Day 10: TALLINN

Tallinn is an ideal destination if one wants to combine the comforts of modern world with rich cultural scene and historic settings. Here you will experience wonderful sights – ancient churches, medieval streetscapes and noble merchants' houses. Throw in delightful food and vibrant modern culture and it's the unforgettable Tallinn.



Day 11: TALLINN – SAREEMAA ISLAND

As the largest of Estonia's islands, **Saaremaa's** natural beauty and interesting history attract both local and international visitors. 



Visitors can view the authentic KGB prison and execution room, and there is a modern exhibition to introduce them to the complex history of the 20th century repressions and the freedom struggles.

Day 3: VILNIUS – GRŪTAS PARK – PLUNGE

Grūtas Park, covering an area of more than 20 ha, serves as an exhibition of almost one hundred ideological monuments and sculptures from Lithuanian cities and towns of the Soviet period, which were dismantled upon restoration of independence. The museum exhibiting such an abundance of ideological monuments is particularly rare – perhaps a unique phenomenon in the world.

Day 4: PLUNGE – HILL OF CROSSES - RIGA

Set up in a former Soviet underground missile silo to present the history of the Cold War that lasted for five decades, this is the only exhibition of its kind in Europe. The exhibition presents the evolution of rocket technology and samples of armament. Visitors can even go down into the actual shaft to see the complex engineering structure where combat missiles were stored 30 metres underground for almost two decades. An object of extreme secrecy in the past, now houses a **Cold War Museum**.

The bunker was built during the Cold War when the Soviet Union maintained constant high alert for a Western attack.

Day 7: TALLINN

Throw in delightful food and vibrant modern culture and it's the unforgettable Tallinn.

HIKING TOUR IN LITHUANIA ANYKŠCIAI

Vilnius – Anykščiai – Vilnius
8 Days / 7 Nights

Day 1: VILNIUS

Arrival in Vilnius. Transfer to the hotel and check-in.

Day 2: VILNIUS

Transfer to **Calvary Cross Hills**. Short hiking there (7 km/3 hrs)

This is a very important historic trail for religious people in Lithuania. It symbolizes Jesus' journey of suffering and even today thousands of believers come here to walk in remembrance of his sacrifices. The stations along the trail represent distances covered in the Bible. If you're not religious, it's still an incredibly beautiful place to visit no matter the time of year.

Transfer to the countryside of Varnikai where hiking at Varnikai **Cognitive Trail** awaits (3,5 - 4 km).

Educative path leads through the most beautiful and hardly accessible places of the preserve, provide the visitors with knowledge about nature, peculiarities of local landscape. Day 4: VILNIUS – ANYKŠČIAI

After an early breakfast, we take a bus to **Anykščiai** with two stops in **Šilėnai** and **Kernavė**.

On your two feet, you can explore a beautiful, forested Neris river valley on Šilėnai cognitive 6 km long route. On this journey, you will see the ethnographic Šilėnai village with a beautiful wooden church from 18th century, the picturesque Neris river valley and dense pine forests,.

Kernavė archaeological site, where the first capital of the Grand Duchy of Lithuania was established in the 13th century, is included in the UNESCO World Heritage List. The five hill forts of Kernavė is also the place from which one can have a view of one of the most beautiful landscapes in Lithuania, ones that inspired Lithuanian rulers centuries ago.



Day 5: ANYKŠČIAI – RUBIKIAI – ANYKŠČIAI

There has been a settlement on the site of present-day **Anykščiai** for a long time, because this place was very convenient not only to live, but also to trade. The rivers Šventoji, and then the Neris and Nemunas, could be used to transport goods to the western parts of the country and the seaside. Anykščiai is a small corner of the earth, where nature and history have made everything rich in Lithuania possible. Here lies the most important stone of Lithuania, the longest Lithuanian river flows here, the tallest church rises here, the only path of the Baltic Tree Crowns stretches - and this is not all the heights of this region.

Hiking starting from hotel > “Happiness Light” on Liudiškės hill > City tour in Anykščiai > Trip by narrow gauge train to Rubikiai and back > hotel (10-12 km)

Day 6: ANYKŠČIAI – NIŪRONYS – ANYKŠČIAI

Traveling along the Cognitive Trail installed on the shore of Šventoji, visitors have the opportunity to appreciate the beauty of the landscape, feel the breath of the city, and stroll in beautifully equipped recreation areas. The health trail on the left bank of the Šventoji falls into a protected area - Anykščiai Regional Park.

Hiking starting from hotel > Šventoji left bank health trail (North direction) > hotel (18 – 20 km)

Day 7: ANYKŠČIAI – PUNTUKAS STONE – ANYKŠČIAI






Day 3: VILNIUS – PLUNGE

After late breakfast walk to train station.

Take train **Vilnius – Plungė** (duration around 3,30 h) 12:00-15:30. Upon arrival you will be having a short City Tour in **Plungė** by bus.

The cultural heritage of **Plungė** region is rich in both material and nonmaterial senses. We can still hear the Samogitian dialect today in the region and find traces of the region's noble past in its old cemeteries, urban development, unique scenery and particularly alive traditions of folk art. There are 9 reservations, 6 natural landscape objects preserved by the state, 4 parks, 13 mounds, 40 monuments of architecture, 29 monuments of art and sculptures in Plungė region. The most unique preserved territory is Žemaitija National Park, the largest part of which is situated in Plungė's region. This is where most of the hiking will occur.




Day 4: PLUNGE

Morning transfer to Plateliai visitor centre (Starting point of hiking).

Welcome to **Žemaitija National Park** with its majestic Lake Plateliai and picturesque landscape including a great variety of unique natural, historical and cultural values. Today you will be hiking **Blue Route** (16 km*). The route is suitable for cycling and hiking. It has many scenic landscapes (forests, lakes, swamps, etc.) You will visit the 3 largest lakes of the Žemaitija National Park - Ilgis, Beržoras and Plateliai, other natural and cultural objects.

Day 5: PLUNGE – KLAIPEDA – PLUNGE

Upon arrival to **Klaipeda** take a ferry (without bus services) to northern tip of the **Curonian Spit** called Smiltynė. Here you will start your hiking. Hiking **Green Route** 13 km Return to Klaipeda by ferry. From this point you will be having **Klaipeda City Tour** by bus. Klaipeda is the 3rd biggest city in Lithuania, an important port and Lithuania's only gateway to the Baltic Sea. The city has a long history starting as a fishing village of ancient Balts and experiencing the arrival of German Crusaders in the 13th century naming it Memel. During the city tour you will see the old Castle territory and the Old Town with the fascinating merchants warehouses in the typical German style with "fachwerk" (half timbered) decorations.



Day 6: PLUNGĖ – PLOKŠTINĖ – PLATELIAI – PLUNGĖ

Transfer to **Cold War Museum in Plokštinė** – the former underground missile base. Tourists can visit the underground and the missile silos labyrinth and get knowledge of the Cold War period, propaganda strategies, consequences of the nuclear explosions and the life in the military base. It offers a rare opportunity to enter the shafts where Cold War nuclear missiles used to stand ready to be launched any minute. Once top secret and still reachable only by a gravel road through a forest, this underground military installation was dug by soldiers using only shovels. Multi-storey complex is barely visible from the outside and can be visited only together with a guide. Museum combines authentic machinery and propaganda posters with new dioramas, plans and screens with period sights and sounds.

After the tour hiking starting from Cold War museum, finishing at Plateliai Visitor Centre (12 km) where the trail leads around the **Plateliai lake**.

Day 7: PLUNGĖ – ŽEMAIČIU KALVARIJA – PLUNGĖ

Transfer to **Žemaičių Kalvarija** (30 km/ 20 min). Hiking starting from Žemaičių Kalvarija, reaching Gardai Esker and ending at Žemaičių Kalvarija (10 km). Gardai Esker. This trail is located on the Gardai Esker, the largest and most imposing esker in Žemaitija (Samogitia). This is a unique in geomorphologic sense shape of land and one of the most picturesque in Lithuania. An esker is a long narrow hill composed mostly of sand and gravel.
